Departments of Natural Resources (DNR) and Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) staff will be on-hand to inform about the process and solicit feedback on both the overall management plan and the plan's environmental review documentation. The meeting is being held at the Swauk Teanaway Grange, 1361 Ballard Road W., near Cle Elum.

Beginning last spring, the agencies have worked closely with a 20-member advisory committee, representing a broad spectrum of interests, to develop the plan. During this time, the agencies and committee held 15 public meetings, two public open
